





Bed Bugs, the Little Menace

The return of bed bugs is a very serious problem for some of us. The sudden resurgence of bed bugs due to insecticide resistance. As we switched from one group of insecticide to another group, these bugs have developed resistance towards insecticides. For the past 20-40 years ago, the bugs could be controlled at lower levels across the world using various classes of insecticides such as chlorinated hydrocarbons (DDT, Chlordane, Lindane), organophosphates (Malathion and Dischlorvos) and carbamates (Bendiocarb, Carbaryl) and synthetic pyrethroids (cyhalothrin, bifenthrin, deltamethrin, and permethrin) (Davies et al., 2012).

The first indicator sign may be bite marks on skin or rashes. Once the bed bugs population stabled and established, a faint musty sweetish odor will developed in the surrounding area. Faecal matter may be detected on the sheets as a dark brownish color spots. By lifting up the edges and seams of the mattress and run a thin piece of plastic through the joints of the colt and discovered tiny translucent white spots that are the eggs and or perhaps brownish mini crawlies. The infestation can be very serious.

Our research laboratory has collected a few bed bugs sample from several locations in Malaysia. Currently we have cultured and maintained bed bugs colonies. To maintain the bed bugs colonies in the laboratory are quite challenging, as they need a consistent blood supply to stay alive. One of the

easiest methods to maintain bed bugs colonies in the laboratory are direct feeding on the forearm (Fig. 1, 2 & 3). Second method, using artificial feeding device, took quite a while before the method can work properly. In this study we used expired human blood from the blood bank. The key point to use this method is to maintain the hot water bath at the right human body temperature around 37oC. We observed less success using this approach to maintain the colony survival (Fig.4).

Using direct feeding on the fore arm can cause some skin reaction. Depend on individual; some might have irritation skin reactions on the bite that can cause rash and not due to allergic reaction to something. The rash may be grouped in a line, which shows the pattern of the insect feeding. Bumps tend to be redder in the following day and might take several days before it fade away. To further understand the bed bug bitten reaction, we have recorded the time interval for the skin reaction to develop after force feed on the fore arm. From the observation, first few red bumps will appear 2-3 hours after force feed (Fig. 5). Tingling sensation will developed too on the skin. After 2 days, the rashes will appear clearly (Fig. 6). After 3 days, the rashes will get more severed (Fig. 7). Depend on individual; the rashes will eventually disappear after one week, if you can discipline yourself from scratching the rashes. Maintaining environment humidity and temperature is very important to maintain the colony survival. We maintain the temperature around 25-290 C, with relative humidity around 65-70%. Temperature above 30oC will lead to the bed bugs to die. We also observed, with high humidity above 75%, fungus will start to grow on their abdomen that can cause death. Currently our lab furthering our studies on the level of insecticide resistance on Malaysian bed bugs population.
